Bank proposed in 1836; non mormon opposition in legislature stopped it.

Anti-bank formed Jan 2, 1837 Vastly over extended; widespread land speculation

Andrew Jackson's Hard money policy lead to The Great Bank Panic of 1837 (Began May 10th)

Joseph Smith discovered bank president had embezzled \$25,000.

Bank fails in November, 1837 Wide spread leadership apostasy Jan 12th, warrant issued for Joseph's arrest.


Flees Kirtland for Missouri due to mobs


